Besides the normal ways to pay your dues, we still have the PUFL (Paid up for life), 10 year, and 3 year methods of paying. Also, if you pay on line, you have the option of allowing the American Legion to post your payment from your credit card each year.

The PUFL program will allow you to spread the payment over the upcoming year. Whichever way you want to pay on-line, just sign in: <https://www.legion.org/renew> You can pay 1 year, 3 years, or PUFL. No need put off asking how much a PUFL will cost, you will see what it will cost, if your birthday is in your record.
